Additional winter information will come in an early November bulletin, along with a notification on when to turn off outside water.

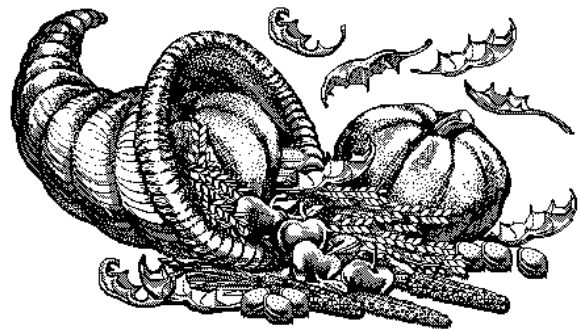
Maintenance news
